The food pantry sources kosher food and distributes it in a dignified way according to the needs of the community at no cost to the recipients. After being run on an ad-hoc basis for 15 years (at times, servicing approximately 158 households, and a total of 459 individuals), the KFP enters a phase of expansion as we move into a permanent home in a newly renovated facility located on the lower level at 77 Englewood Ave. Brighton MA. The KFP is recognized by the Greater Boston Foodbank and runs according to their strict standards of operation, sanitation and food safety.
